

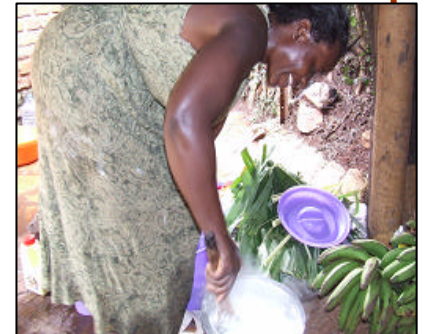
Mto Moyoni is a retreat centre on the banks of the river Nile in Uganda. Ingrid Wilts, a missionary, started this centre in 2003. In Swahili the name Mto Moyoni means: 'river trough the heart', and this name also expresses the goal of the centre: to offer Christian workers a time of peace and quiet to experience that the Spirit of Gods wants to flow like a river through their hearts. Ingrid works together with Winette Hubregtse. In Uganda Mto Moyoni is registered as an NGO. In the Netherlands their work is supported by the Friends of Mto Moyoni foundation.

Dear friends of Mto Moyoni,

First of all a big thank you for all of you who have been praying with us these last months! Sickness really brought problems, especially for some of our staff and their children. Joyce's one year old daughter was very sick with cerebral malaria and Joyce thought at one point that she was going to loose her. Slowly she started to feel better and is again very healthy at the moment. Peter, one of the caterers fell sick and decided to resign. Moses came in his place and is being trained at the moment. Lydia gave birth to a beautiful baby boy! All is well and she is now on leave for 2 months. Staff is a ministry on its own. Most of these young people are from broken families, grew up as orphans or lived through war and are carrying the wounds.

Spiritually we regularly experience the fact that we are working in the frontlines. Darkness tries to disorganise. Therefore we took last month a whole morning out to worship and pray around the compound. Light is stronger than darkness and we are learning more and more to hide in Fathers hiding place. In Him we have the victory and He is going before us. The enemy has no chance! Great to witness that every time again and learn more to stand in His victory!

During the last year we had a couple of special visits from people who just walked in to bless us and minister to us. Mark Stibbe was one of them (St. Andrews, Chorleywood, U.K.) and a few weeks ago a team from his church walked in and we had a very special time of worship and prayer with them. It is such a blessing that our Father knows what we need and that He brings us the right people in the right time. Great to see that He is building His network all over the world.

The programmes and certainly the transformation weeks have been very busy. More and more people sign up for it. The ministry is growing which is a blessing but it is now time for a break first. My leave is coming up and I will be in Holland from June 19 till August 18. I am starting off with a one week "Father loves you" forum held in the Netherlands. James Jordan from New Zealand is organising this European Forum and it is meant to receive ministry and to network with other ministries world wide. As you know we have building plans for the new land we bought!

I myself want to see much more progress in our new development, but when I was talking this over with the Lord, and asking Him which actions He would want me to start, he gave me a simple childish Dutch song in my mind: it ends like this: "I stood by and watched....", It was as if the Lord was telling me: "I am doing it for you, you will stand by and watch, it is not your project, but Mine!"

So I just go on waiting, exercise myself in patience, and know that He is going to do it. The permits, the money, the people, He will do it for me! That is not a simple task for a person like me, but I am making progress, I leave it in His capable hands. That gives me peace and I am looking expectantly forward to see His promises coming to reality!
