Ingrid works together with Winette Hubregtse. In Uganda Mto Moyoni is registered as an NGO. In the Netherlands their work is supported by the Friends of Mto Moyoni foundation.

Back in Uganda!

It always is so good to come home again! Staff is welcoming me with flowers on the gate, at the door of my house, in the room and even on the veranda! Beautiful fragrance and colours.

But it is also shocking to get confronted again with the differences, although I am very familiar with the scenes around. European roads and the Ugandan ones are incomparable and than all other dangers here and the spiritual darkness.

On the 2nd day Droppy, our black dog, found a big black cobra in its hole just down from my bedroom doors. One of the gardeners killed it! Our two hero's!

Something else what struck me was an article in the newspaper about the 'rainmakers': three witchdoctors were given money by the villagers to please the spirits in order to have them bring rain. Because no rain was to be seen, two of them where lynched by an angry mob, one was able to run away. Middle-age practices!

Something else what caught my attention while listening to a sermon during these first weeks was this: "Why is God sending us out as lambs among wolves? Because the Lion is walking besides us." It is good to be back, knowing that the Lion is right there at the place where He asks us to be. That is the safest place!

Last week we had twenty participants in the transformation week. All of the people had gone through bad awful storms in their lives, some of them with no hope left, no life left. Our soul can be so broken and pressed, but we saw again that with God it is never beyond healing. Freedom and rest instead of chains and depression.

I explained that we had given this place to God and that He loves His children and knows what they need. When the ladies left they said: "We would like to know more about this God and will try to come back for a program".

Was it Fransiscus van Assisi who said: "evangelize the world and if need be use words"?
